



CAP Debt Help Referral Fact Sheet

What is CAP?

Christians Against Poverty offers free debt help services in partnership with local churches. CAP specializes in face-to-face home visits to help individuals and couples implement a debt payment plan and put together a sustainable budget. CAP provides an action plan to help them get financially stable and if possible, debt free.

Are CAP workers trained?

Yes. The credit counseling work is undertaken by AFCPE trained credit counselors. Our face-to-face volunteers are trained by CAP to deliver our professional service.

Who should be referred to CAP?

CAP's service is available to anyone in financial difficulty, but our service has been tailored to make it accessible to those on low incomes and financially and socially disadvantaged.

Is the service only for Christians?

No. In fact, over 90% of our clients worldwide are not Christians. Our service is available to anyone regardless of race, nationality, religion, age, gender, marital status, sexual orientation, or disability. We work hard to make it known through our marketing material that we help anyone regardless of beliefs or any other factor.

Is there a charge for your service?

No. It is completely free with no upsell for any services at any point. We are funded through private donations to ensure this service is accessible to all who need it.
